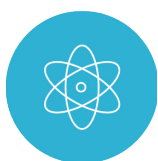
IT'S ALL ABOUT DATA SECURITY

Snow's Data Intelligence Service automatically updates with the GDPR-relevant information, providing continuous protection.

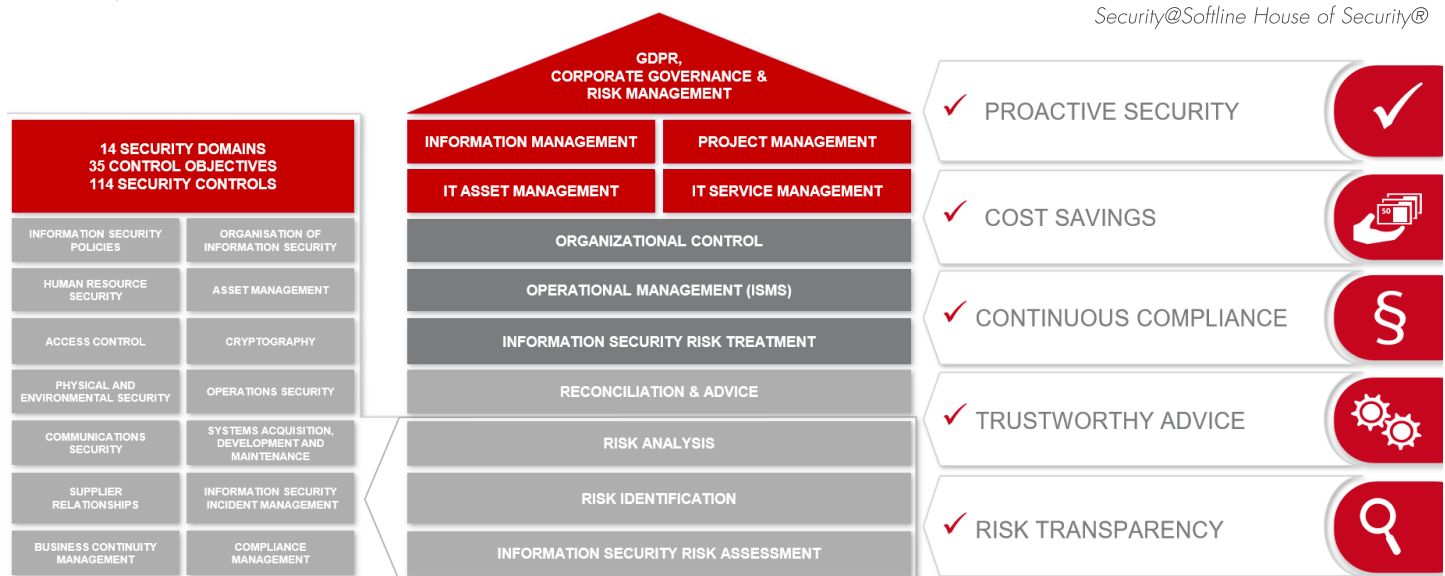
